Under the leadership of Artistic Director and Principal Conductor Grete Pedersen and Executive Director Stephen Friedlander, the organization offers innovative artistic programming across all concerts, off-season activities to expand access outside Carmel and the Monterey Peninsula, and is taking strategic risks to cultivate younger and more diverse participants.


